2023 GENERAL RULES

1. Pit Passes...All persons entering the pit area must have a pit pass and sign a release form, and must wear armband on arm only.

2. Rain Check Policy...Absolutely no money refunded. Rain checks will be honored only for tickets that have the appropriate number for rainouts. There will be NO exceptions. Make-up race date will be determined and announced at time of postponement. Again, there will be NO cash refunds. Any time a race is cancelled and two features have been completed, the race will be considered complete and no rain checks will be issued.

3. Drivers... A driver must be 13 years of age with proof of age. Any driver under the age of 18 must have a notarized Release of Liability Statement and permission from their parents or legal guardian.

4. MANDATORY: All drivers must wear approved helmet and full one or two-piece fire suit, racing shoes, and racing gloves.

5. All drivers must attend driver's meeting.

6. Any driver suspected of being under the influence of alcohol will be required to take a Breath-O-Lizer Test. If positive, the driver will be charged with DUI by the Emanuel County Sheriff's Department.

7. No participant shall subject any employee or official to improper or abusive language or signs at any time.

8. All drivers are responsible for the actions and conduct of their crew.

9. If any driver or crew member crosses onto racing surface to talk, inspect, exchange words (with another driver), or work on race car, crew member will be removed from racetrack and car in which crew member is affiliated with will be black flagged and disqualified. This does apply under a red flag situation as well. Unless, escorted by an official. NO EXCEPTIONS!

10. Speeding in the pit area will result in one of the following: Laps being taken away, or being sent to the pit, or being suspended.

11. Anyone caught fighting will go to jail and pay the \$500.00 Cash Bond. If anyone approaches another race car or goes to another racers pit and trouble ensues, that person will be considered "in the wrong." 12. Golden Isles Speedway reserves the right to fine, suspend, or bar any driver, owner, or pit crew for unruly conduct.

13. All drivers must use receivers for hot laps, heats, qualifying, and features. Receivers and Transponders are mandatory anytime your car goes onto the racetrack.

14. A racecar that is driven in two classes on the same night IS required to pay two separate entry fee's (per each class).

15. This rule book is a guideline and can be subject to changes, drivers will be notified at the next driver's meeting of any changes, and the rule change will take effect the next week. Weight may also be added for infraction of any rules at the tech inspector's discretion. Rule changes will be posted on our website.

16. Fire extinguishers are REQUIRED to be in your hauler, enclosed trailer, etc. at all times on our grounds in case of an emergency.

17. THE ABSENCE OF A SPECIFIC RULE DOES NOT IMPLY APPROVAL, CONSENT OR PERMISSION REGARDING THAT SUBJECT. ANY QUESTIONS OR DOUBTS REGARDING SUCH MATTERS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO RACE TRACK OFFICIALS FOR A CLARIFICATION
